
MENTAL HEALTH



LITERACY MOMENT

- 2. Phonics Recognizing the connection between letters & the sounds they make.
- 3. Vocabulary Understanding the meaning of words, their definitions, & their context.
- 4. Comprehension Understanding the meaning of text.
- 5. Fluency The ability to read aloud with speed, understanding & accuracy.
