DON'T - Park in the Kiss & Drop lane



The capacity to think before you act. The ability to resist the urge to say or do something allows us the time to evaluate a situation and how our behavior might affect it.


Challenges can look like:

- Misinterpreting information and instructions
- Difficulty listening to instructions before beginning a task


Strategies to Support Response Inhibition:

- Provide clear and concise instructions
- Close proximity to an adult
- Redirect in a calm manner
- Teach wait/stop
- Delayed gratification
- Model thought process
- Removal of environmental distractions
- Provide time with an adult to make connections
- Display classroom/home rules and review often/
