Challenges can look like:

- Difficulty keeping track of items and/or information
- Messy workspace (e.g. desk)
- Messy living space (e.g. bedroom)
- Difficulty remembering important dates
- Forgetting materials for class
- Misplacing classwork and/or other items
- Difficulty with transitioning between classes and/or tasks
- Difficulty with time management

- **Model organization**
- Use colour coding/labelling systems
- Calendar with important events listed
- Use a homework log to keep track of important information
- Weekly reset/organize of backpack/binders
- Clean desks and lockers weekly
- Use graphic organizers
- Create to-do lists/checklists
- Clean up after tasks


IMPORTANT INFORMATION




