EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONING - PLANNING & PRIORITIZING

The ability to create a roadmap to reach a goal or to complete a task. It also involves being able to make decisions about what's important to focus on and what's less important.

Challenges can look like:

- Difficulty keeping track of important events
- Forgetting to hand in work/missing due dates
- Difficulty starting a task
- Difficulty prioritizing tasks
- Difficulty starting/completing homework
- May start a project but not finish it
- Overwhelmed when planning
- Forgetting important materials for class or other activities

Strategies to Support Response Inhibition:

- Teach how to use a planner and calendar
- Have multiple checkpoints for larger tasks
- Model breaking down a task into manageable steps
- Teach how to create checklists
- Make "to do" lists and rank the items in order of importance
- Map it out draw out plans
- Prompt with questions ("what materials do you need?")
